MoU signing ceremony was held on December 7, 2018 between Project Coordinator Syed Zulfiqar Hussain with Principal Hsaasn Ashrif, Principal Aftab Zain and vice principal Syed Shahbaz Shah. DATH/YOCFAN declared as Smoke & Drug Free Campus.
- Aas Foundation Treatment & Rehab Centre Mr. Asif Shahzad the Manager along with other staff participated in the meeting regarding treatment service for substance use disorder, admission & counselling program etc. on December 2018. Syed Zulfiqar, Dr. Ikram, Ms. Saima Shahzad and Syed Mohsin participated. Both organization agreed that DATH/YOCFAN will refer all patients to Aas Foundation with low cost treatment facilities.
- One Day Teacher Training Workshop for Focal Person on Drug Use Prevention Organized by YOCFAN & DATH on 19 December, 2018 at DATH/YOCFAN Office Allama Iqbal Road Lahore. Syed Zulfiqar Hussain and Ms. Saima as trainer talked about the different aspects of drugs, which include its types, risk & protective factors followed by answer and question. Role & responsibilities about drug use prevention were also given to participants to make the program effective and result oriented.
- 3rd Teacher Training Session - Induction Training for Assistant Professor was organized by PHEC at Punjab Higher Education Commission in the Training Hall University of Education, Township Lahore in collaboration with YOCFAN/DATH. Syed Zulfiqar Hussain, Consultant Anti Drug/ Narcotics Campaign delivered on basic drugs, risk and protective factors, role of teachers the lecture followed by exercise.
- Grand Convention on Drug Use Prevention organized by DATH/YOCFAN at Lahore College for Women University (LCWU) in collaboration with PHEC, Directorate of Colleges Lahore, Colombo Plan and INL. Minister for Energy Govt. of the Punjab Mr. Akhtar Malik was Chief Guest and VC Dr. Farkhanda Manzoor of LCWU presided over the convention. Ms. Seemia Tahir MPA, Mr. Shuja Ahmad Khokar, Deputy Dir Colleges Lahore, Mr. Tahir Bashir, Director Training Punjab Higher Education Commission, Mr. Muhammad Ayub Senior Advisor, Colombo Plan, Dr. Zahir Javed, Pro Rector, University of Faisalabad, Syed Amjad, Deputy Dir Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department and TV Anchor Mr. Fahad Shahbaz Khan were participated as Special Guests. - The Punjab prohibition Sheesha Smoking and Crystal Ice Bill 2019 had been tabled in Punjab Assembly, the bill draft prepared by Syed Zulfiqar Hussain, Consultant, Anti Drugs/Narcotics Campaign and MPA

Ms. Seemia Tahir visited DATH/YOCFAN office on December 8, 2018. Syed Zulfiqar detailed discuss on drug addiction among youth/students, awareness program against drugs, treatment and rehab programs and coordination with different government departments. She said that if Mr. Hussain will draft a bill against crystal ice and Sheesha then I will table in the first week of January, 2019. Mr. Hussain completed the draft of Bill 2019 and handed over to Ms. Seemia Tahir MPA.

- Project on Strengthening Drug Demand Reduction Services in Pakistan (SDDRSP) has been closed in December and we done a lot with follow up and monitoring programs. This project remained much effective and result oriented in term of setting new trend of drug use prevention and developing working coordination with various government departments and organizations. Management of DATH/YOCFAN recommended to replicate similar program in all over the province in future.

Challenges:

Again our program implementing teams had been facing some challenging since last two and half month because of newly designated provincial Ministers and Officers from government departments but we over come the challenges organizing different meetings with the head of different government departments. We made clear to different provincial ministers and government officers to make them understand about our objectives, mission, goals and different ongoing activities on drug demand reduction and drug use prevention. Project Coordinator Syed Zulfiqar along with his implementing team had to work hard to meet these challenges. At the moment YOCFAN and its implementing team has met these challenges successfully in the month of December. Now these officers and Ministers have been stream lined to understand our programs and mission.
